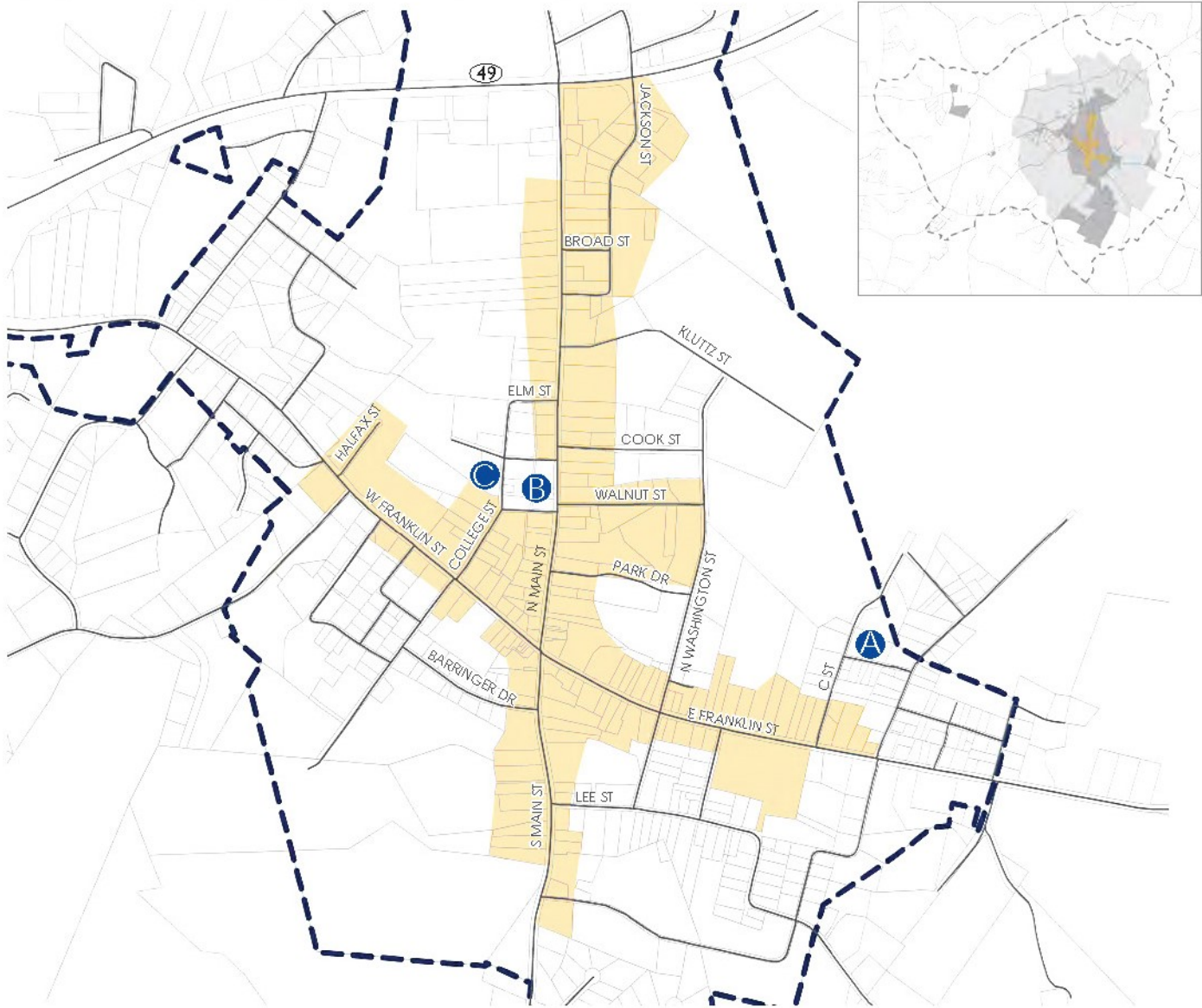
Please be informed that the Town of Mount Pleasant is working with contractor hmwPreservation to conduct survey work in order to update information for the Mount Pleasant National Register Historic District, under the oversight of the North Carolina State Historic Preservation Office. **Field survey work will primarily be taking place February 11 through February 20, with additional follow-up through the end of February.** Field work will occur throughout the entire Mount Pleasant National Register District and will include Main Street, Walnut Street, parts of Franklin Street, Elm Street, College Street, Cook Street, Kluttz Street, Broad Street, and Jackson Street (south of Highway 49). **A map of the Mount Pleasant National Register District is attached to this letter for reference.** Consultants with hmwPreservation will be photographing the front of structures within the district from the public right-of-way and making notes of changes and demolitions that have occurred since the last survey was conducted in 1978.

The Town of Mount Pleasant received a federal Emergency Supplemental Historic Preservation Fund Hurricane Disaster Relief Grant from the National Park Service following Hurricane Florence. The two-part project covered by the grant involves updating the Mount Pleasant National Register District Architectural Survey and National Register District Nomination Form. It also includes studying stormwater infrastructure in the downtown portion of the District to make recommendations to protect contributing historic structures in the Downtown from future heavy storm events. All grant activities are under the oversight of the North Carolina Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, State Historic Preservation Office.
